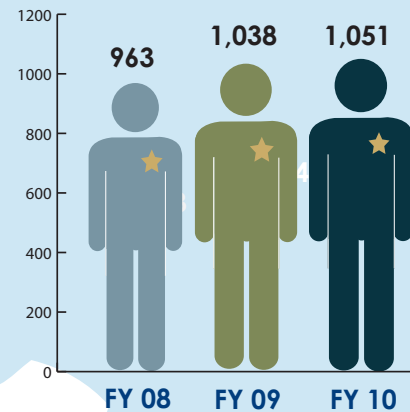
### CORNEA GRAFTS

Unlike organ transplants, the waiting list for cornea transplants has been virtually eliminated. Thanks to improved availability of transplantable tissue and an advanced surgery scheduling system, many patients are now able to schedule their transplants on a routine basis.

## RESEARCH AND TRAINING

Midwest Eye-Banks provided 2,696 tissues for research and training to doctors and scientists during Fiscal Year 2009-10, marking the third consecutive year that the organization was able to increase the amount of research tissue it supplied to the scientific community. In addition to being used for transplantation, eye tissue can positively impact many lives when used by researchers hoping to discover the causes of and cures for blinding eye conditions.
